








FUNCTIONING OF THE ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall function as follows:

- 1. Surprise Inspections:** The Squad shall conduct unannounced rounds of the campus including hostels, classrooms, laboratories, mess, common areas, corridors, and parking lots at irregular intervals, at least twice a week.
- 2. Reporting:** The Squad shall report all findings, observations, and incidents directly to the Anti-Ragging Committee and the Head of the Institution in writing within 24 hours of observation.
- 3. Logbook Maintenance:** A dedicated logbook shall be maintained by the Squad In-Charge recording dates, times, areas covered, observations, and actions taken during each patrol round.
- 4. On-the-Spot Enquiry:** The Squad is empowered to conduct on-the-spot enquiries into any ragging incident referred to it by the Head of the Institution, as per UGC Regulation 6.3(e).
- 5. Natural Justice & Fair Procedure:** All enquiries conducted by the Squad shall strictly observe fair and transparent procedures and the principles of natural justice. Adequate opportunity shall be given to the accused student(s) and witnesses to present facts, documents, and views before the Squad, as mandated by the UGC Gazette of India, July 4, 2009.
- 6. Enquiry Report:** The Squad shall submit its enquiry report along with recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action under Clause (a) of Regulation 9.1 within 24 hours of completion of enquiry.
- 7. Reporting:** The Squad shall report all findings, observations, and incidents directly to the Anti-Ragging Committee and the Head of the Institution in writing within 24 hours of observation.
- 8. Logbook Maintenance:** A dedicated logbook shall be maintained by the Squad In-Charge recording dates, times, areas covered, observations, and actions taken during each patrol round.
- 9. Coordination:** All Squad members shall coordinate with each other and with the security personnel during inspections. The Squad operates under the supervision and direction of the Anti-Ragging Committee.
- 10. Availability:** Squad members must be reachable on their listed contact numbers at all times during working hours. Contact numbers shall be displayed on notice boards for student reference.
- 11. Awareness:** The Squad shall actively participate in anti-ragging awareness sessions, orientation programs, and assist in distributing UGC anti-ragging undertakings to students and parents.
- 12. Confidentiality:** All complaints received and investigations conducted shall be treated with strict confidentiality. No Squad member shall disclose the identity of a complainant or victim.
- 13. Zero Tolerance:** The Squad shall ensure absolute zero tolerance towards ragging in all its forms as defined under UGC Regulations 2009 and the Prevention of Ragging Act.
- 14. Annual Review:** The composition and performance of the Squad shall be reviewed annually by the Head of Institution and Anti-Ragging Committee before the commencement of each academic year.

All concerned members are hereby directed to take note and comply accordingly. This order comes into effect immediately.
